September 11th has taken on the historical significance of events like Pearl Harbor and the assassination of JFK. If you survived or witnessed the attacks on September 11th, your experience is an essential part of a turning point in history. Every week, thousands of visitors from across the country and around the world come to the Tribute World Trade Center Visitor Center to go on walking tours of the World Trade Center site. All tours are lead by volunteers directly affected by September 11th, including: rescue and recovery workers, survivors, first responders, family members who lost loved ones, eyewitnesses, volunteers and downtown residents. Tribute Center volunteers give walking tours of the World Trade Center site that incorporate the events of September 11th with telling their personal stories.

STANY members have an important voice to add to the Tribute Center's volunteer program. By sharing your experiences about September 11th, you will connect visitors to what happened that day in uniquely meaningful and powerful ways.

Tribute Center volunteers lead tours to honor the memory of friends, loved ones and family members and to pay tribute to acts of generosity, sublime courage, selflessness and love. At the Tribute World Trade Center Visitor Center, our mission is to present history that reflects human nature and prevents future generations from making similar tragic mistakes.

Becoming a walking tour guide for the Tribute Center gives volunteers a sense of acknowledgment, community, affirmation and a way to heal. Tribute Center volunteers gain insight from one another and are invited to attend free lectures and presentations.

Tours last about one hour and are offered daily, throughout the day. The time commitment is flexible, one or two tours a month, plus a weekend training session. Volunteers are carefully trained thoroughly supported during and after the training process.
